2011 Council Bluffs USBC Youth Championship Bowling Tournament Rules and Information

Last year's highest Council Bluffs yearbook average must be used (USBC rule 319a), minimum of 21 games. If the bowler has no previous average, the highest current average in any Council Bluffs sanctioned league as of January 1, 2011, at least 21 games shall be used. Non-sanctioned high school federation bowlers must buy a USBC youth membership and have a verifiable 15 game high school federation average. If none of the above, the bowler must use a scratch figure of 190.

DIVISIONS WILL BE BASED ON THE FOLLOWING

Div 1	110 & up	220 & up	440 & up
Div 2	under 110	under 220	under 440

Handicap shall be 100% from 220 in each event in each division.

CHECK-IN

Bowlers must check-in at least 30 minutes before scheduled time to bowl.

LATE BOWLERS

Squad times will not be delayed by late bowlers. A late bowler may start bowling in the current frame upon arriving. They will receive no score for missed frames.

ENTRIES

Turn in your entries to Al Alsman (Thunderbowl) or Sandy Hanna / Todd Shanno (Lightning Bowl) or Dan Underwood, (Regal Lanes) with all entry fees, or you may mail your entry directly to **Al Alsman PO Box 461, Treynor, Iowa 51575. Make checks payable to Council Bluffs USBC.** There will be a \$25.00 service charge for all returned checks.

All USBC youth tournament and playing rules will be followed including but not limited to: No swearing, no tobacco products, no clothing displaying tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, or profanity, no playing coin operated games or electronic devices of any kind while bowling, no hats and no cell phones will be allowed to be "ON" while bowling.

Singles bowlers must bowl doubles and doubles bowlers must bowl singles. Doubles entries must consist of two (2) bowlers. Team entries must consist of four (4) bowlers.

You may bowl more than once in doubles as long as each entry has a different partner.

You may bowl more than once in team as long as no more than two (2) bowlers are the same on each team.

The first score bowled in each event will be used to determine All Events pin count.

Awards will be presented in each event. Number of awards will depend on number of entries.

Tournament Manager or designee has final decision to resolve any disputes not specifically covered by USBC Tournament and playing rules.

Scholarships will be awarded in each event.
