The Nominating Committee will be taking applications for the Council Bluffs USBC Association, Board of Directors. The Nominating Committee is a standing committee of appointed individuals that have experience with the business and sport of bowling. The individuals on the committee will not be eligible for the board positions.

The Council Bluffs USBC Association has a total of 21 board positions. Positions to be filled at this election are listed below. Applications may be turned in to the designated location at each of the bowling centers or they can be given to current Council Bluffs USBC board members. Forms should be returned by **March 31ST**. You may run for more than one position, which will require a form to be filled out for each position.

Only the following positions will be elected to fill the combined board at this time.

The term and duties of each office is listed below.

Terms of Office

President – 2 Years

Vice President – 3 Years

Director – 3 Years

Eligibility

- a) Must be an association member in good standing at the time of election and throughout your term of office.
- b) Must be a minimum age of 14 years, unless state laws mandate a specific age, and be reasonably representative of the membership. Any member of the board authorized to sign contracts or acting as a signatory on association accounts must be a minimum age of 18 to meet bonding requirements
- c) Must not be bowling in an unsanctioned American Tenpin League.
- d) Must demonstrate a working knowledge of the sport of bowling and the industry.
- e) Must demonstrate leadership qualities and the ability to think strategically as it relates to board responsibilities.

The following is a brief description of authority and duties of the board positions. If you would like additional information please contact one of the current board members.

President – This individual manages key relationships with the National and State organization/association. Presides at all meetings and acts as spokesperson for the association. Enforces and/or complies with bylaws, USBC performance standards, USBC policy manual, and appoints committees with board approval.

Vice President – Attends all meeting and presides at all meetings when president is absent. Performs other duties as prescribed by the board or requested by the president. Enforces and or complies with bylaws, USBC performance standards, and USBC policy manual.

Director – Attend meetings and perform duties requested by the president or prescribed by the board such as participating/chairing committees or assisting with tournaments.
